1. REPORT FOR DECISION – RELOCATION OF MODULAR TOILETS TO DEVIZES CEMETERY

Recommendation

That the committee agrees that the modular toilets currently located at Hillworth Park are relocated at Devizes Cemetery.

Purpose of the Report

To give officers approval to relocate a Town Council owned modular toilet to the cemetery and to agree funding for its installation.

Background

As part of the refurbishment of Hillworth Park, the current modular style toilets will be redundant. Officers are suggesting that a suitable new location for this facility will be at the cemetery situated close to the barrier.

The toilet is self is self-contained, with a wash hand basin and a coin operated locking system. There is power near, although it is anticipated that a small septic tank will be needed.

Officers are currently seeking quotes for the installation, which will need to be funded by the Joint Burial Committee.

It is not uncommon for visitors to the cemetery to ask if there are toilet facilities, therefore locating this unit will be a popular addition to the cemetery.

Options Considered

The committee needs to decide if they are happy for the modular toilet to be located within the cemetery and that they are happy to pay for its installation.

Implications & Risks

Financial and Resource Implications

The cost for this work will need to be met from reserves and the maintenance budget.

Legal Implications and Legislative Powers

The open spaces act 1906, Ss 9 and 10 gives the parent councils the power to acquire and maintain burial grounds.

Environmental Implications

Officers are not aware of any environmental implications associated with this decision.

Risk Assessment

Officers are not aware of any risk implications associated with this decision.
