9. REPORT FOR DECISION – LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION) ACT 1982 APPLICATION FOR STREET TRADING CONSENT – MASONS FRUIT AND VEG

Recommendation

To consider an application from Masons Fruit & Veg to modify their current Street Trading licence.

Purpose of the Report

To consider an application from Masons Fruit & Veg Ltd who have applied to Wiltshire Council for modification to their Annual Street Trading Consent outside 4 The Brittox.

The modification to the existing licence is to allow for their stall to be doubled in length (the width would remain the same) and allow trading every Thursday.

Background

On 2nd December this committee raised no objections to an application from Masons Fruit & Veg Ltd for Street Trading Consent. This application was for a position outside 4 The Brittox (M&Co), consisting of tables and umbrellas which will be approximately 20ft in length and 8ft in width. The request also included trading times of Tuesday, Friday and Saturday from 8am to 4pm the positioning will be similar to that of Superior Plants, in the middle of the Brittox.

However, Wiltshire Council has now received a request to double the length of the stall and to allow trading every Thursday.

Attached to this agenda is Wiltshire Council's Criteria for determining applications (doc 9/1).
