On the 21 July, Wiltshire Council signed off the Devizes Area Neighbourhood Plan following the Independent Examination.

**8. REPORT FOR DECISION – VARIATION OF ALCOHOL LICENCE, THE BLACK SWAN, DEVIZES**

**Recommendation**

That the committee considers an application from Wadworth & Co for a variation to the alcohol licence for the Black Swan, Market Place, Devizes.

### **Purpose of the Report**

To give the committee the opportunity to consider a variation to the alcohol licence for the Black Swan, Market Place, Devizes to include the outside area.

### **Background**

Currently The Black Swan has a licence to sell on and off alcohol sales within the premises. Wadworth & Co is now seeking a variation of that licence to include the beer terrace and external covered servery (doc 8/1).

The variation will allow for waiting staff to take drinks orders in the beer terrace and also sell alcohol from the outside servery, 7 days a week from 12 noon.

The servery will cease selling alcohol at 9pm and beer terrace will close at 10pm.
