199. REPORT FOR DECISION – PROPOSED "NO WAITING AT ANYTIME" PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON QUAKERS WALK

After much discussion, particularly around enforcement, it was proposed by Councillor Johnson, seconded by Councillor Mrs Rose and agreed

THAT the committee defers making a decision until the Town Council contacts Wiltshire Council asking them to investigate whether parking restrictions could be limited to “dropping off” and “picking up” times during school term time, as this is when the problem seems to present itself, rather than enforcing a blanket restriction.
