7. REPORT FOR DECISION – FREE PARKING ALLOCATION

The report is a continuation of a report on the 2 February, which recommended that the committee noted Wiltshire Council's intention to change the way it allocates free parking for events and decide if it wishes to make any comments on the proposals.

It was agreed at that meeting that the portfolio holder for the highways contract be asked to attend a future meeting to provide some clarification to the future options.

Councillor Whitehead has agreed to attend the meeting and answer the committee's questions.

Once the committee have debated the issue, it needs to decide if it has any comments on a temporary free parking allocation for towns that if it wishes to make to Wiltshire Council.

8. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF: B3098 (PART) WESTBURY, BRATTON, EDINGTON, COULSTON, ERLESTOKE, CHEVERELL MAGNA, CHEVERELL PARVA AND WEST LAVINGTON

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic: B3098 (Part) Westbury, Bratton, Edington, Coulston, Erlestoke, Cheverell Magna, Cheverell Parva and

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West Lavington; from its junction with Newtown, Westbury to its junction with A360 High Street, Littleton Panell.

To enable: Wiltshire Council to carry out kerbing, carriageway resurfacing / patching work, road marking and adjustment of ironworks.

Alternative route: via A350 – A361 – A360 and vice versa.
