The general consensus was that the policy needed clarification as members were unsure as to why the Market Place, which is a free of charge parking area, is included within the policy. Members also queried Wiltshire Council's numbers on the amount of parking spaces given for events during 2015.

THAT Devizes Town Council rejects the policy document with its current caveats and requests clarification including how many spaces have been used for events and how the Market Place is used.
