207. QUESTION TIME

Councillor East asked if officers are aware of the reason why the double yellow line scheme agreed for Queens Road has not be implemented yet. Also asked if it was possible to chase up Wiltshire Council.

The Deputy Town Clerk clarified the history of this scheme and advised that even after several attempts to shed light on progressing the scheme, no information had been forthcoming.

Councillor Evans said that several areas of Devizes have been designated to receive double yellow lines which included Queens Road, Hillworth Road and Avon Road and that they should be completed by the end of the year.
