8. REPORT FOR DECISION – INSTALLATION OF “NO ENTRY” SIGNS AT ONE END OF ESTCOURT CRESCENT

Recommendation

That the committee consider supporting a request for “No Entry” signs by Morrison's carpark steps in Estcourt Crescent to deter vehicles from travelling further along Estcourt Crescent.

Purpose of the Report

To consider the installation of “No Entry” signs at one end of Estcourt Crescent.

Background

Residents of Estcourt Crescent have approached Councillor Mrs Evans asking if “No Entry” signs could be placed adjacent the steps into Morrison’s carpark, to stop speeding cars going up the road the wrong way along the street. The residents have asked if the Town Council would support the cost of the installation of signage, which will be in the region of £1250, with a 25% contribution from the Town Council. If the Town Council supports the request it will be passed on to the Community Area Traffic Group.

Options Considered

The Committee needs to decide if it supports the request from residents for the installation of “No Entry” signs.

Implications and Risks

Financial and Resource Implications

An indication of the cost of the signs is set out in the report, Devizes Town Council has a budget to support local highway initiatives and improvements.

Legal Implications and Legislative Powers

The Council will be considering this matter under its General Power of Competence.

Environmental Implications

Officers are unaware of any environmental implication for the Council associated with this decision.
