  4. 14/11202/FUL – 2 storey extension at 9 Waterside Park, Devizes. SN10 2TG. There were no objections
  5. 14/11002/FUL – demolish porch & construct single storey extension at 9 Moonrakers, Devizes. SN10 There were no objections.
  6. 14/11159/TPO – remove / prune trees at Wayside, Roundway Park, Devizes. SN10 2ED. There were no objections.
  7. 14/10983/FUL – new 9 bed residential care unit - Green Lane Hospital, Devizes. No objections were raised.
  8. 14/12042/FUL - erection of 6 foot fence at 6 Osmund Close, Devizes. SN10 3GW. There were no objections.
  9. 14/00129/TCA – fell trees at Campfield House, Thomas Wyatt Road, Devizes SN10 5EE. After discussion it was decided there was no objection to removing dead wood but that the reasons suggested do not justify removal of an historic tree.
  10. 15/00048/ADV – retrospective consent for advertising boards – Saint Cars, Garden Trading Estate, London Rd. Devizes. SN10 2HW. It was proposed by Cllr. Wooldridge, seconded by Cllr. Rowland and approved unanimously that the council approve the fixed advertising but object to the application for ‘A’ boards for safety reasons due to danger to traffic when blown by the wind.

### **287 NEW BUS SHELTER AT NEWMAN ROAD**

The clerk circulated details of costs and photographs of various options. After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Stevens, seconded by Cllr. Rowland and approved unanimously that the council purchase the Euroshel bus shelter option, 3m x 1m.

### **288. FINANCIAL REPORT**

The clerk had previously circulated the financial report. It was proposed by Cllr. Geddes, seconded by Cllr. Batchelor and approved unanimously that the report be accepted.

### **289. GRANTS & DONATIONS**

- 1 Wiltshire Citizens Advice Bureaux. It was proposed by Cllr. Vonverg, seconded by Cllr Wooldridge and approved unanimously that the council make a grant of £50.
- 2 Wiltshire Portage. After discussion it was decided that the council should restrict grants to organisations which are directly benefitting residents of Roundway parish. The clerk will respond accordingly.
3. For information – Devizes Budo Club have enquired re S106 funds towards new clubhouse. The clerk advised that the project does not qualify for existing S106 funds as the criteria are very specific.

### **290 S106 FUNDS**

Cllr. Rowland suggested that the council should be consulted regarding constraints placed on S106 money. It was proposed by Cllr Rowland, seconded by Cllr. Vonberg and approved unanimously that the clerk be directed to write a suitable letter to

Wiltshire Council.

### **291 GULL NUISANCE**

A report by NBC (pest control experts), which details options, with costs, for control involving flying of predatory birds, was circulated prior to the meeting. Cllr. Mayes addressed the meeting regarding this issue. After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Wooldridge, seconded by Cllr. Vonberg and approved unanimously that the council fund 50% of the annual cost to a maximum of £5,000, to engage the services of predatory birds. Devizes Town council will be approached with a request that they contribute the balance.

### **292. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN**

Cllr. Rowland updated the meeting and the council reiterated that they still have support for the Neighbourhood Plan.

### **293. ALLOTMENTS.**

Cllr Wooldridge updated the meeting regarding current status. He outlined a three year maintenance agreement regarding the tank and the council agreed to purchase this service.

### **294 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Cllr. Wooldridge will be entering the allotments into Britain in Bloom.

Cllr. Vonberg concerned about rubbish on streets. Cllr Batchelor will address this via Clarence.

The clerk advised that Cllr. Rugg requested he advise the council about her concern about increased traffic in Byron Road due to the allotments, Skate Park and the proposed new development.

Cllr. Wooldridge asked that the vacancy be entered on the agenda for the next meeting. An application for co-option has been received.
