



1. Application ref. 15/07829/FUL – new conservatory at 33 Broadleas Crescent, Devizes, Wiltshire, SN10 5DH. After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Vonberg, seconded by Cllr. Stevens, and approved unanimously that the council make no objection.

2. Application ref. 15/07332/VAR – to remove condition 8, the requirement for a footway link from the former Katherine McNeil site to the carriageway at Green Lane. Cllr. Batchelor outlined the proposal and after discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Parsons, seconded by Cllr. Wooldridge, and approved unanimously that the council object to this application in the interests of community benefit.

3. Application ref. 15/08324/FUL – change of use from agricultural to business at Wiltshire Heavy Building Materials, Hopton Industrial Estate, Hopton Road, Devizes, Wiltshire, SN10 2EY. Cllr. Batchelor outlined the proposal. After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Rowland, seconded by Cllr. Corbett, and approved unanimously that the council support this proposal.
