Apologies were received from Cllr. Batchelor (in hospital), Cllr. Stevens (ill health) and Cllr. Parsons (conflicting engagement). These were accepted by the meeting.

94 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

Resolved: that the Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 16th November 2015, which had been circulated, are approved as being a correct record and signed as such by the chairman

95 UNITARY COUNCILLOR`S ITEMS

Cllrs Mayes attended and provided a brief report. She advised that there will be a requirement for Wiltshire Council to make savings of £25 million next year and answered questions from councillors.

96 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND POLICE REPORT

PC Andy List attended, provided a brief report on impending changes to local policing, and answered questions. No members of the public were present.

97. FINANCIAL REPORT

Resolved – To accept the financial report, previously circulated.

Resolved – To approve items of expenditure totalling £8,029.82, as detailed.

98 GRANTS AND DONATIONS

An application for funding from Devizes & District Link was discussed. It was proposed by Cllr. Valentine, seconded by Cllr. Geddes and approved unanimously that the council make a grant of £250.

99 COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW

Cllr. Callow provided an update including anticipated costs related to the Joint Governance Committee. It was proposed by Cllr. Wooldridge, seconded by Cllr Steel and approved unanimously that the council adopts the following documents which were previously circulated.

100 PRECEPT & BUDGET FOR 2016/17

Various budget alternatives, previously circulated, were discussed. It was proposed by Cllr. Corbett, seconded by Cllr. Collis and approved with eight in favour, none against and one abstention, that the budget be adopted for 2016/17. The details are shown in the attached document, which will be circulated by the clerk. It was also proposed by Cllr. Steel, seconded by Cllr. Vonberg and approved with eight in favour, none against and one abstention, that the precept be set at £98,446.87

101. SPEED INDICATION DEVICE SHARED WITH ADJOINING PARISHES– FOR CONSIDERATION AND DECISION

This matter was discussed and it was proposed by Cllr. Geddes, seconded by Cllr. Collis and approved unanimously, that the council do not join an application for speed indication device.

102 REPORTS FOR INFORMATION

Cllr. Valentine raised two matters briefly discussed at the last meeting, seeking views for discussion at CATG - speeding issue at Nursteed village and speeding / parking issue at Folly Road.

Resolved: that Cllr. Valentine contact CATG regarding the speed humps at Nursteed Village with view that Wiltshire Council be requested to enforce the planning decision regarding placement of speed humps.

Cllr. Rowland reported that the Neighbourhood Plan has been formally adopted by Wiltshire Council.

Cllr. Wooldridge passed a cheque for £35 to the clerk re allotments rental.

Cllr. Callow reported a traffic issue at Drews Mill. He will carry out further research regarding crash history.
