78 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

1. Application ref. 15/10713/WCM - to extend date and vary conditions relating to Saturday working at Broadway Farm, Nursteed. After discussion it was agreed that the application should be opposed on the same grounds as before.

2. Application ref. 14/09447/FUL - to amend previously approved application for new building on plot adjacent to 44 Roundway Park. The document did not make clear what changes were requested. Therefore it was agreed to allow Cllr. Geddes to make further enquiries and advise members by e mail.
