1. Julia's House – Planned opening of 8 -10 unit children's hospice nr Braeside, Devizes, September 2017.
2. Daisy - Individual Placement Unit, on the Green Lane hospital site. July 2016

He also stated that he encouraged and supported the merging of the Devizes Town & Roundway Parish Councils to achieve savings in the delivery of public services and forming a body capable of considering the adoption of areas such as Pine Walk for which he had private finance to clear up

68 REPORT FOR DECISION – CREATION OF A JOINT GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE OF DEVIZES TOWN COUNCIL & ROUNDWAY PARISH COUNCILS

Cllr. Callow read through the report and after discussion it was decided

Proposed by Cllr Geddes, seconded Cllr Rowland that a Joint governance committee of the Devizes & Roundway councils be created. Passed unanimously

Proposed by Cllr Valentine seconded by Cllr Von Berg that Cllr. Callow, Cllr. Stevens, Cllr. Rowland, Cllr. Parsons & Cllr. Geddes were appointed as Roundway representatives and that Parish Clerk Johnson should attend meetings. Passed unanimously

69. FOLLY ROAD

The concerns raised by local resident Mr Partrick Suther concerning parking was raised by Cllr Valentine who reported that she would meet with Mr Suther on 20th October to observe this parking and report back to the Parish Council and CATG

70 PEDESTRIAN CROSSING, WINDSOR DRIVE (NURSTEED COMMUNITY SCHOOL)

Cllr Valentine read to the council the conclusion of the summary provided by Cllr Whitehead for the Highways and transport, Wiltshire Council that no further action would be taken as the existing facilities are appropriate for the level of demand. This decision is now with the school governors to review.

71. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Cllr. Rowland updated the meeting regarding progress and reported that the referendum had delivered a significant majority in favour and that the next three stages were

1. Implementation by Wiltshire County Council
2. Approaching developers
3. Response to the Potterne neighbourhood plan

Cllr Rowland proposed, seconded by Cllr Callow that the council's response to the Potterne Neighbourhood plan would be made following its review and comment by the Joint Neighbourhood plan committee which would be given by Cllr Rowland at the next Parish meeting
