108 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

110 POLICE REPORT

WPC Teresa Herbert attended, described her current role and presented a report on local issues. She then answered questions from councillors.

112. REPORT FOR INFORMATION AND DECISION REGARDING PLANNING MATTERS.

1. 16/10161/LBC – Repair and reinstatement of fire damage at Home Farm, Roundway Parl. Devizes. SN10 2EG. Cllr. Geddes described the application and no objections were made.

2. 16/10443/TPO – cut back beech tree by 2 metres - Speer Court, Thomas Wyatt Road, Devizes, SN10 5FH. Cllr. Geddes described the application and no objections were made.

3. Application 16/10857/FUL - new chill pipe condenser and associated cabling & pipework at Haydens Bakery, Hopton Road. Devizes. SN10 2EU. Cllr. Geddes described the application and no objections were made.

4. 16/10684/FUL - new entrance canopy and cladding at DS Smith, Mill Road. Devizes. SN10 3EW. Cllr. Geddes described the application and no objections were made.

5. 16/10924/LBC - Internal alterations, installation of roof light and replacement front door at 4 Wyvern, Awdry Rd. Devizes, SN10 5NU. Cllr. Geddes described the application and no objections were made.

Cllr. Geddes also referred to a previous amended application regarding Hatfield House. His enquiries suggested that there were no planning grounds to object to this application.

Cllr. Valentine invited feedback on her report last month. Several items were discussed briefly.

116 GOVERNANCE REVIEW

Cllr. Callow provided an update. Several issues were raised including the use, by the local newspaper, of an old photograph of councillors, all of whom were from Devizes Town Council, against a background scene in Roundway parish and with no Roundway councillors included. This generated concern that the wrong message will, potentially, be disseminated to Roundway residents.

117 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Cllr. Rowland provided an update and sought clarification regarding the granting of planning permission at Quakers Walk. Cllr. Callow explained the background to the hearing. Cllr. Geddes also expanded on the background to the process.

118 ALLOTMENTS.

Cllr. Wooldridge provided an update on the allotments and the Green Lane playing field project. It was proposed by Cllr. Steel, seconded by Cllr. Wooldridge and approved unanimously that the council tarmac the lower end of Green Lane at a cost £12,500.00 + VAT.

119 MATTERS FOR INFORMATION

Cllr. Rowland suggested inviting NHS to address a future meeting regarding proposed development at Marshall Rd.

Cllr. Wooldridge introduced 'shed clubs' and reported that he is involved in the creation of one in Devizes, probably to be located at Victoria Road, though temporarily starting at Greenacres. He will report further as soon as possible.

Cllr. Callow reported on a talk he gave to Salisbury regarding Neighbourhood Plans.

He also raised the state of information signs at the White Horse. The clerk will investigate the cost of refurbishing them.
