### 296 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Cllr. Jacobs (conflicting commitment) & Cllr Mayes (illness). These were accepted by the meeting.

### 297. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST

Cllrs. Wooldridge & Geddes disclosed an interest in the matter at para.310. Cllr. Geddes also disclosed an interest in application15/01428/FUL (8 Awdry Road) in that he knows the applicant.

### 298. MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The chairman was authorised to sign the minutes as a true record of the meeting on 19<sup>th</sup> January 2015.

### 299. UNITARY COUNCILLOR`S ITEMS

No Wiltshire councillors were present.

### 300. REPORT FOR INFORMATION AND DECISION REGARDING PLANNING MATTERS.

1. Application 15/00828/FUL. – Conservatory at 2 Nursted Meadows, Devizes. SN10 3HL. No objections were raised.
2. Application 15/01304/TCA – remove deadwood and reduce size of group of poplars at Newman Road. Devizes.SN10 5LE.

Cllr. Geddes also informed the council of an appeal by Clenche Properties regarding the refusal of planning permission for a building at 48 Hartmoor Road. Devizes.

SN10 5HJ. (Application APP/Y3940/W/14/3002066) It was decided, with unanimous consent, that Cllr. Geddes will write and reiterate the council's earlier objections.

Cllr. Geddes informed the meeting of an application to build 123 houses on land adjacent to Quakers Road. He will circulate details for consideration and this will be considered at the council meeting on 16 March 2015.

Cllr. Batchelor outlined an application for conversion of a garage and building of a conservatory at 8 Awdry Road. There were no objections raised.

### **301. NEW BUS SHELTER AT NEWMAN ROAD**

The clerk updated the council regarding progress. Concerns were raised by Cllr. Wooldridge regarding space for pedestrians. The clerk will re-circulate options for an alternative design, open at both ends.

### **302. FINANCIAL REPORT**

It was proposed by Cllr. Geddes, seconded by Cllr. Steel and approved unanimously that the finance report be accepted.

### **303 COUNCIL VACANCY**

Mr Peter Corbett attended the meeting and answered questions from councillors. He then left the meeting whilst his application was discussed. It was proposed by Cllr. Rowland, seconded by Cllr. Steel and approved unanimously that Mr. Peter Corbett be co-opted to serve as a councillor on Roundway Parish Council.

### **304. GRANT APPLICATIONS**

1. Devizes & District Link – It was proposed by Cllr. Parsons, seconded by Cllr. Valentine and approved unanimously that the council make a grant of £250.
2. CPRE The council is a member of CPRE and it was proposed by Cllr Rowland, seconded by Cllr. Callow and approved unanimously that the council continue to retain membership at a cost of £36.

### **305. DOG BIN – ALAN COBHAM ROAD**

A request for a waste bin at Alan Cobham Road was received from Mrs M Rowland. It was proposed by Cllr. Wooldridge, seconded by Cllr. Geddes and approved unanimously that the council fund the capital cost of a bin and approach Wiltshire council regarding disposal arrangements.

### **306. SIGNAGE BANNING MOTOR VEHICLES FROM PATH AT QUAKERS WALK**

Cllr. Valentine will raise this matter at CATG.

### **307. DEVIZES MESSENGER**

Cllr. Wooldridge reported on interim arrangements following resignation of Cllr. Job. Cllr. Collis will act as liaison on behalf of this council.

### **308. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN**

Cllr. Rowland provided an update.

### **309. ALLOTMENTS.**

Cllr Wooldridge provided an update. He is investigating the purchase a 10ft. metal

container for safe retention of equipment and will report back at a future meeting.

**310. COMMUNITY GOVERNANCE REVIEW**

Cllr. Callow provided an update regarding progress. There will be a meeting of a working group on 4 March 2015.

**311. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

There were no members of the public present.

Cllr. Stevens and others raised concerns about likely traffic problems arising from building work at the junction of Byron Road and Green Lane. The clerk will seek details regarding conditions attached to planning consent re access.

Cllr. Wooldridge asked that the white horse be cleaned up prior to May. The clerk will arrange this.
