83. CO-OPTION OF A NEW COUNCILLOR.

Councillor Rowland (Vice Chairman) in the chair.

It was proposed by Councillor Rowland and seconded by Councillor Parsons that Miss Hannah Callow of 46 The Fairway, Devizes be co-opted as a councillor for the remainder of the term of the council. All agreed.

Miss Callow was welcomed as a new councillor. She signed the usual declaration.

83A ALLOTMENTS-PLANNING

Following a full presentation by Councillor Wooldridge, members approved the plans for the allotment site to be submitted to Wiltshire Council.

It was resolved that:

1. Councillor Wooldridge should act as the agent for The Parish Council in connection with the submission of the plans and other matters relating to the allotments that have been previously agreed.
2. A fee of £167.50 is paid to Wiltshire Council for planning permission.
3. Councillor Parsons would assist in completing the planning application.

The chairman thanked Councillor Wooldridge for his work. Members concurred with this statement.
