**314. FOR DECISION – EASTLEIGH ROAD BUS STOP**

Councillor Nash advised members that the creation of a bus stop clearway would not require formal consultation but could be referred to CATG for approval and would cost £1500. The missing bus stop sign would be replaced as general maintenance.

It was proposed by Councillor Nash, seconded by Councillor Oliver and unanimously AGREED

THAT the committee accepts the proposal to refer this issue to Devizes CATG, requesting that a bus stop clearway be installed at the Eastleigh Road bus stop location; and further that the Council representative at the CATG meeting is authorised to increase the Town Council's contribution from 25% to up to 40% of the total cost, if that would enable the project to be prioritised.
