### **85. MINUTES**

The minutes of the meeting held on the 7<sup>th</sup> June 2022 having been circulated to all members were confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

### **86. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received from Councillors Mrs Britten, Mrs Gay, Hunter, Greenwood and Ormerod.

### **87. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST**

Councillors Nash and Wallis both declared an interest in item 89, as members of Wiltshire Council's Eastern Area Planning Committee.  
Councillor Oliver declared a non-pecuniary interest in planning application PL/2022/04342, as it relates to a neighbouring property.

### **88. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

There were two members of the public present; neither wished to address the meeting.

### **89. FOR DECISION – WILTSHIRE COUNCIL'S NOTICE OF PLANNING APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION**

PL/2022/04342 - It was proposed by Councillor Oliver, seconded by Councillor Hopkins and AGREED

THAT the committee objects to the application for reasons of overdevelopment of the site; it being situated close to the boundary and in overlooking the adjacent property (Rosemundy Cottage) will cause an unacceptable loss of privacy.

PL/2022/04212 - It was proposed by Councillor Hoult, seconded by Councillor Oliver and AGREED

THAT the Committee objects to the application because of the impact of traffic on the area resulting from the loss of available parking spaces and a further demand for parking for the new housing.

The committee received and noted the report.

**91. FOR INFORMATION – TRAFFIC SURVEY RESULTS, A361 BATH ROAD**

The report was received and noted. Officers were asked to pursue the request for a light-controlled crossing.

**92. FOR DECISION – NEW PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION, HOPTON INDUSTRIAL ESTATE**

It was proposed by Councillor Oliver, seconded by Councillor Geddes and AGREED

THAT the Committee has no objection to the application.

**93. QUESTION TIME**

Councillor Oliver asked that the next meeting considers the matter of speeding on London Road.

Councillor Wallis noted that the area around Caen Hill should be cleared of debris and rubbish. Officers advised that it was hoped that it could have been done whilst Wiltshire Council has a carraway way closure in place, but lack of communication meant the Town Council was not aware when this happened.

Councillor Wallis had received a complaint about the problems of pigeons in the Market Place and Brittox, and asked that this matter is considered by the next Community & Civic Resources committee.
