“The new half of the Quakers Road development was envisaged to link with the old half via a pathway. However, the path was only constructed to the boundary of the new half. I receive regular complaints and representations from Roundway residents about this situation, which makes access problematic for buggies / older citizens and many others. Would the Council be prepared in principle to endorse the use of CIL or Section 106 monies to complete the path at a price including VAT of around £20k, subject to residents making their wishes clear on this subject and a full plan being submitted?”
