5. REPORT FOR DECISION – STREET NAMING, NEW MARSHALL ROAD DEVELOPMENT

Recommendation

That the Town Council puts forward names for the new housing development to be constructed off Marshall Road.

Purpose of the Report

To decide if this Council wishes to put forward any names for the new housing development to be constructed off Marshall Road.

Background

Wiltshire Council's street naming team have been in contact with officers, as for new developments which involve the creation of new streets, the street naming and numbering process requires developers to carry out consultation with the relevant town/parish council to agree suitable street names.

Devizes Town Council has been asked to put forward suggestions for five new roads to be constructed as part of the new development off Marshall Road.

Whilst five names are needed, it is recommended that seven names are put forward to allow for names that may not be agreed.

Where a name of either a living or deceased person is to be used as part of the street naming, additional authorisation needs to be gained from either the person or the family.

Wiltshire Council has asked that the Town Council puts forward its name suggestions by the 11th July.

On the suggested layout below each of the five roads have been given different coloured arrows, with the main estate road in red and the other roads shown with blue, pink orange and green arrows.



Options Considered

The committee needs to decide if it wishes to put forward names for the new estate, and if so which names.
